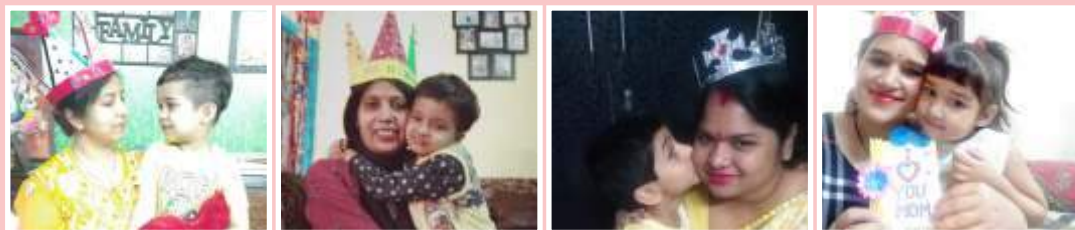

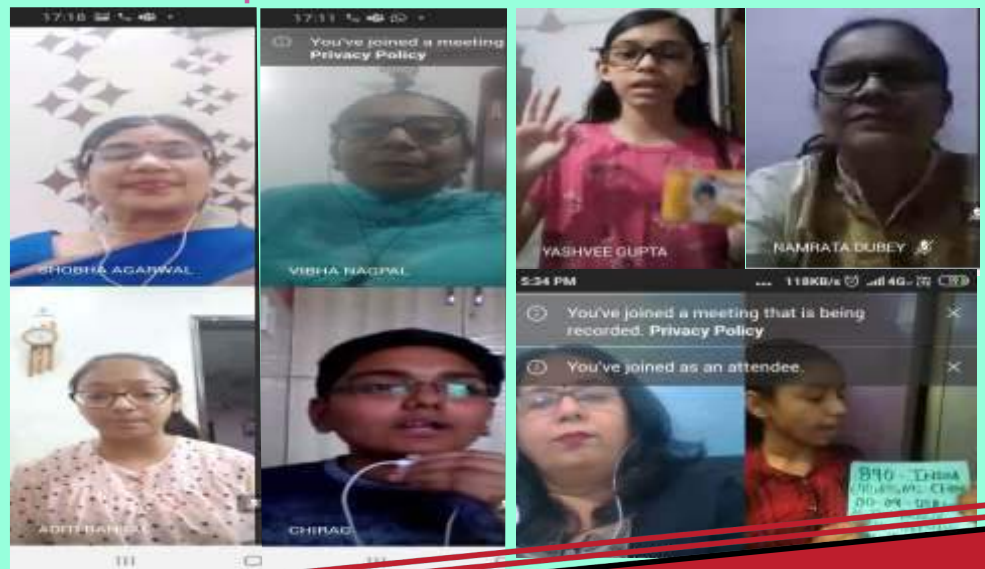
ENHANCING SCIENTIFIC TEMPERAMENT

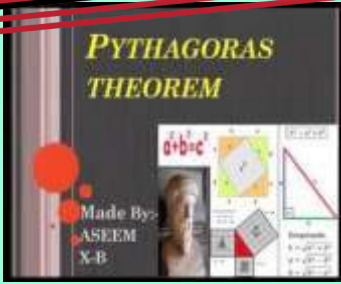


The Science Department organised a skit to depict how to fight with the COVID19. A general awareness was spread through the skit. The creativity and rational thinking was at heights in the skit.
