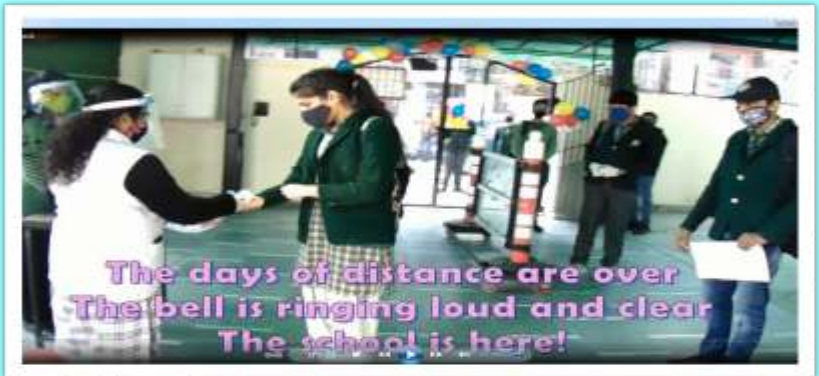
Likewise, was the experience of almost last one-year COVID-19, an outburst of a deadly virus that engulfed the universe with adverse impact.

The prestigious 17th M. L. Budhraj Memorial Rolling Trophy went to **The Red Roses Public School, Saket**.

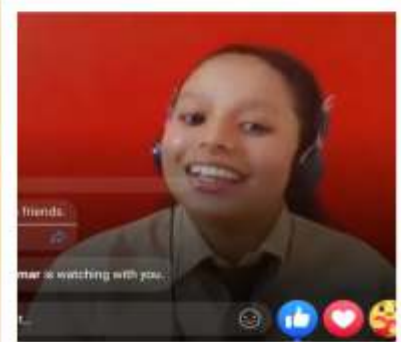

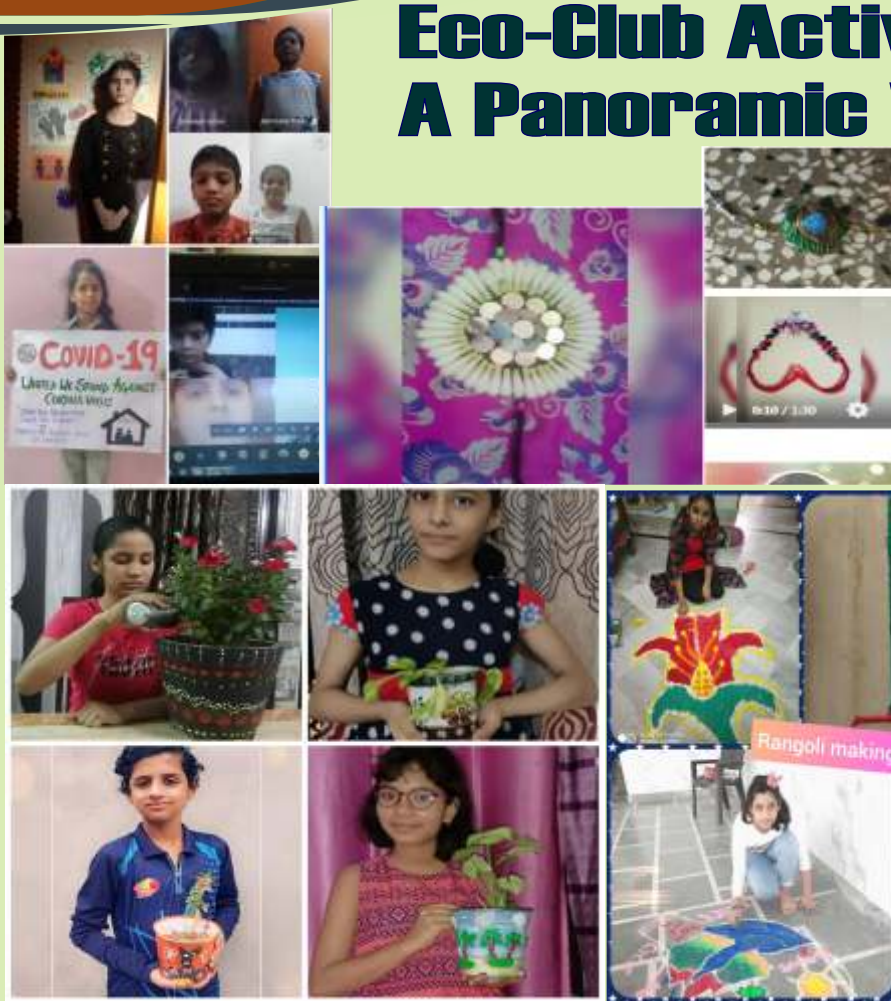
Keeping the spirit Alive
