"Growing your own food is like printing your own money."

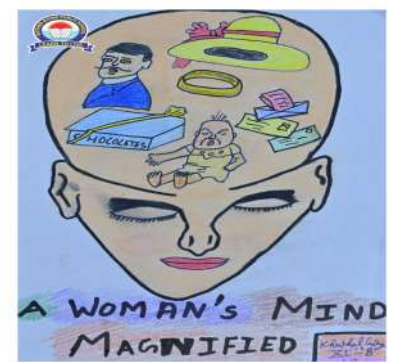
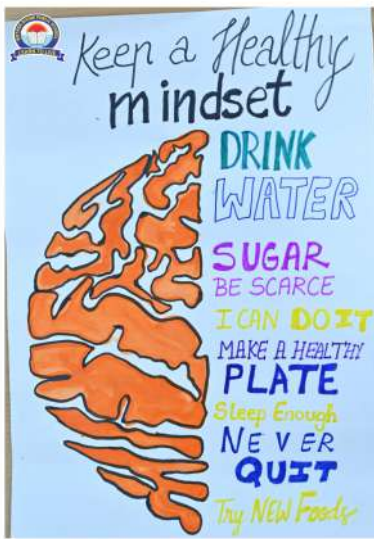
