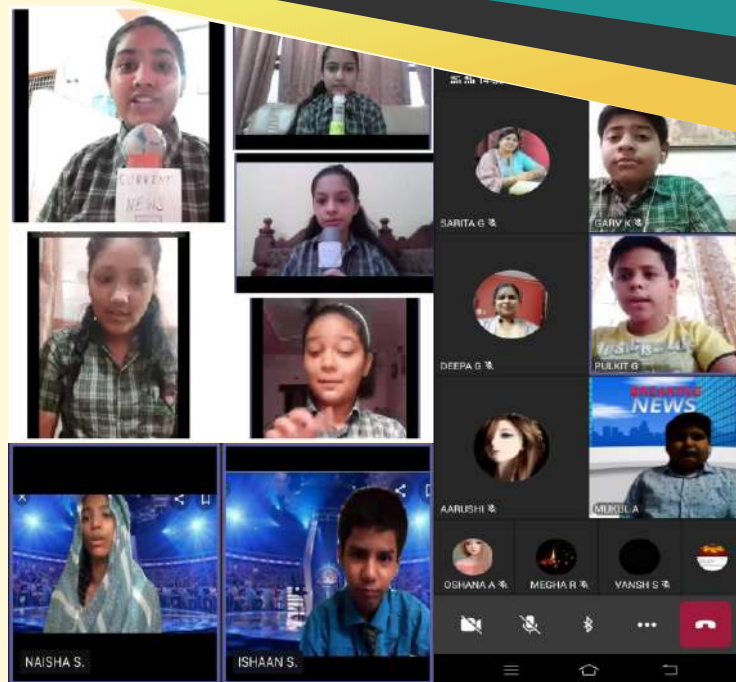
ENGLISH CLUB

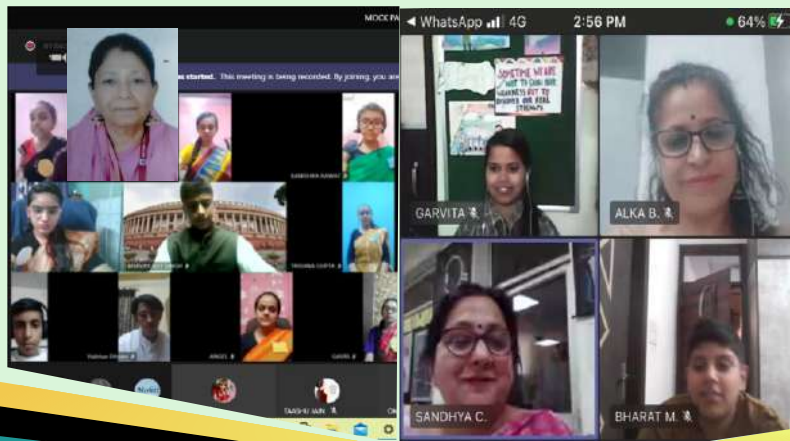


Study Of Successions & Systems Of Society

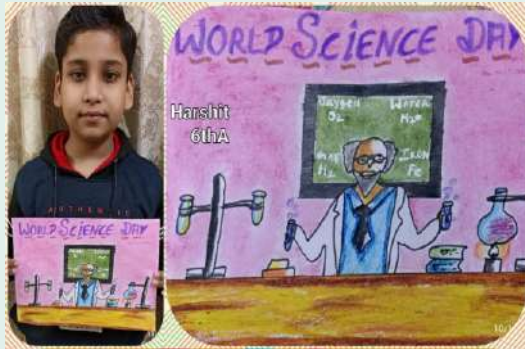


SEIVING SECRETS OF SCIENCE

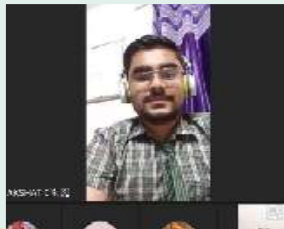

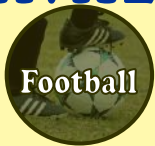
CAREER COUNSELLING WEBINAR

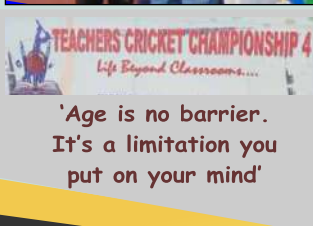
YOGIC ACTIVITIES

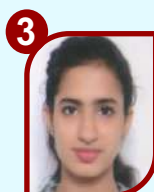

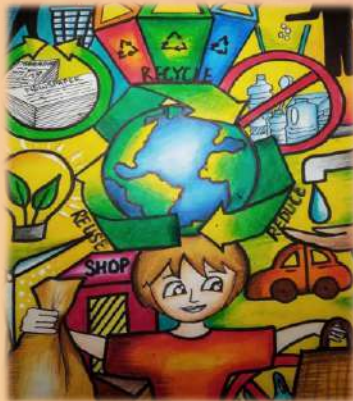
