Diwali Celebration



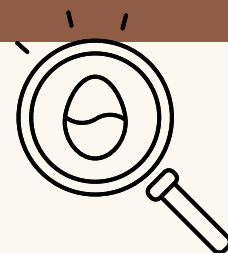
“Diwali is a celebration of light, hope, and new beginnings. Let's illuminate our hearts with this celebration”

“Creativity shines brighter when we work together!”

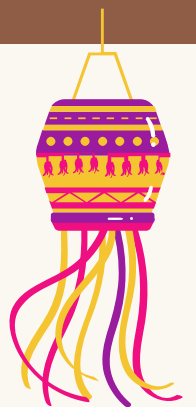

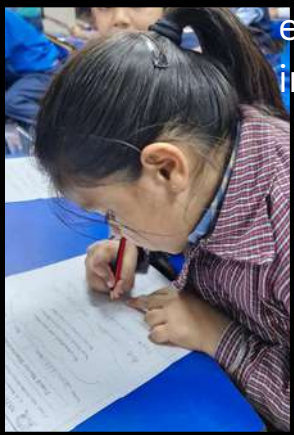


Pencil Master Handwriting Competition

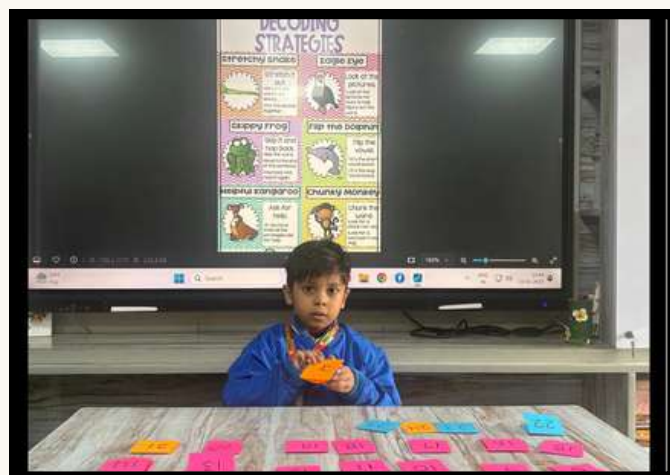


Treasure Hunt

Self-Discipline Drive

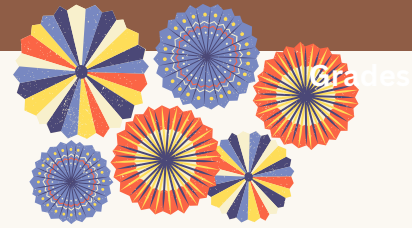
“Through discipline comes freedom.”

Republic Day & Sports Day Celebration

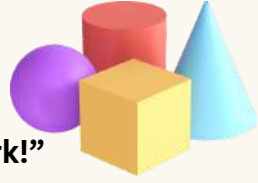
“Patriotism is the foundation of unity and sportsmanship is the bridge that brings us together”

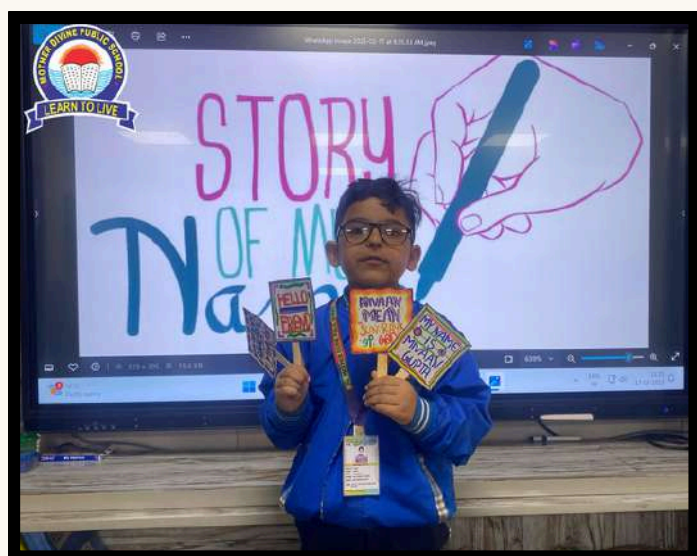


Story of my name activity

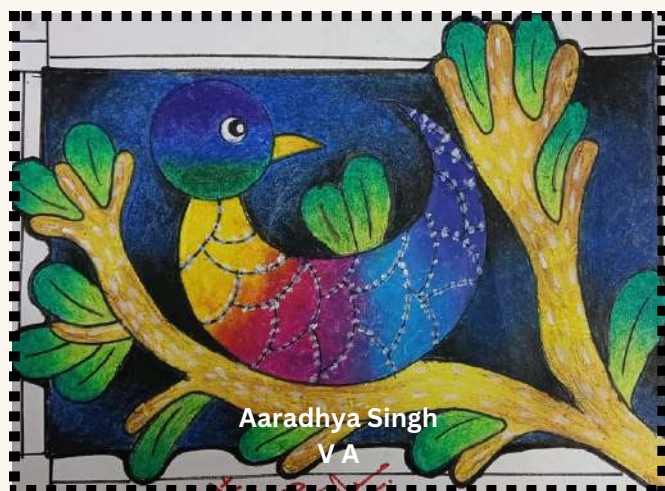
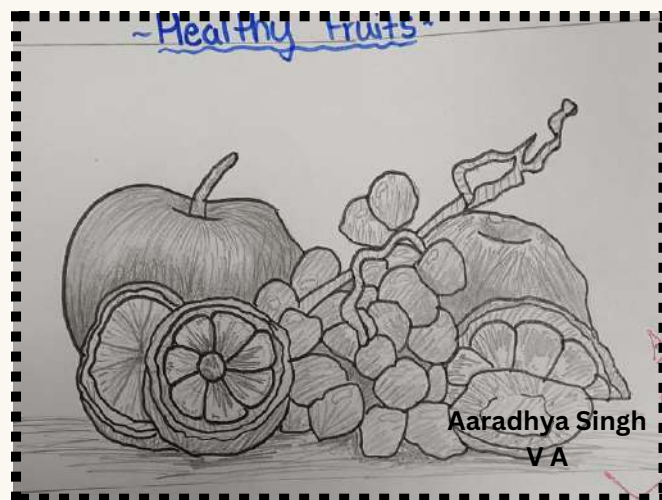

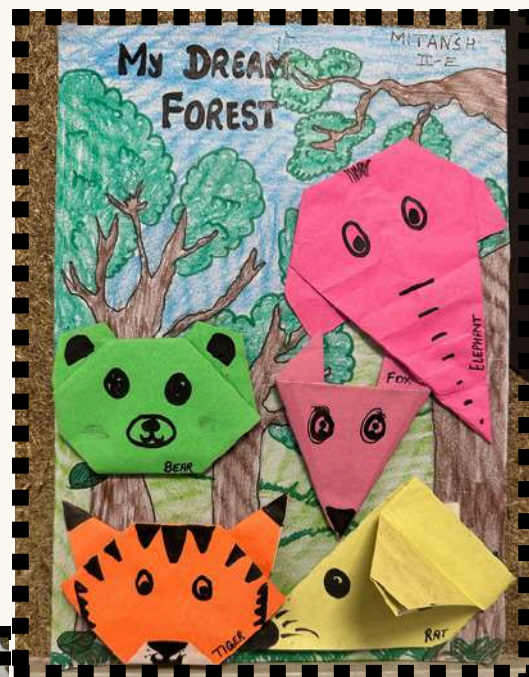
